

COVID -19 UPDATE

We hope this letter finds you and your family in good health and spirit. All of us are looking forward to resuming our “normal” habits and routines. While many things have changed, one thing has remained the same: our commitment to your safety.

Infection control has always been a top priority for our practice. Our office follows infection control recommendations made by the American Dental Association, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration. We have made some changes to help protect our patients and staff. Some examples are:

- 1) Appointments will be managed to allow for social distancing between patients. This means that you will be offered fewer options for scheduling your appointment. We ask that you call ASAP to reserve your appointment.
- 2) You may see that our waiting room will no longer offer magazines, children’s toys, refreshments and so forth, since those items are difficult to clean and disinfect.
- 3) Our office will communicate beforehand to ask Covid-19 screening questions. You will be asked those same questions again when you present for your appointment.
- 4) You will wait in your car and call when you arrive. We will call/text you when it is time to enter.
- 5) **Masks or face covers will be required to enter the office.**
- 6) We will limit personal items brought into the office, including handbags and outerwear. **Cell phones will not be allowed in the office.**
- 7) We will take your temperature and ask you to use hand sanitizer when you enter the office.
